

SUBMITTING A “WHY SYNOD” VIDEO

How to Submit:

Access Flipgrid: <https://flipgrid.com/1e99315e>

- This will take you to the homepage for the video space. Here you can watch other videos and/or record your own.

You have two recording options....

Recording through flipgrid (this is the easiest/quickest way to submit):

- Click on the “record a response” icon (there are two, a rectangular one and the big giant hot pink/red pulsing circle next to the videos that have already been presented).
- Follow the onscreen prompts to record, review, and submit your video
 - Record your video. Once you are done, click “next”.
 - You then have the chance to do small edits (take off sections or add something). Once you are done (or if you don’t need to), click “next”.
 - Fill out the “display name” field. It usually defaults to your first name and last initial, but you can change that.
 - You also have the option to upload a selfie on this page (there are icons underneath the video preview box), which will be used as the thumbnail image for your video.
 - If you don’t upload a selfie, it will use a still image from the beginning of your video.
 - Once you are done, click submit.
- Be sure to follow the submission process all the way to the end where it tells you it has been submitted. Click “done” at the end to go back to the homepage.
 - You won’t see your video on the homepage yet. We have it set so all videos have to be approved before they are available.

Uploading a previously recorded video:

- Click on the “record a response” icon (there are two, a rectangular one and the big giant hot pink/red pulsing circle next to the videos that have already been presented).
- Click on the “options” icon to the left of the record button.
- Choose “upload a clip”.
- Upload your file (flipgrid only supports .MOV, .MP\$ or .WEBM video clips)
 - If you choose to upload a video we highly recommend you read Flipgrid’s [help page on the topic](#)
 - If you have recent tech (smartphone, iPad, etc); the video program on your device should record in an accepted format. But be sure to double check.
 - Uploading often works better when uploading a video file from your phone (the program was built for use on smart phones).
- Follow the on screen prompts to review and submit.

Note- there is a 90 second limit on your video submissions. You will not be allowed to exceed 90 seconds (1 and a half minutes).
